ENERGY LABELS CAN HELP

Appliances that don't yet have the rescaled energy label

Smaller appliances (e.g. a smaller sized TV) will use **less energy overall** than a larger model but may have a lower energy rating. Therefore, make sure you use the energy labels to compare energy consumption.

Low consumption could also be achieved **by operating the appliance correctly.**

Don't forget to recycle the product properly at the end of its life.
